1. Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission (SCCRTC)

1. Potential Sales Tax Measure
 1. At the request of the RTC, the Committee will construct its own proposed expenditure plan. It will be presented to the RTC upon completion. **(COMPLETED)**
 2. The RTC Board has instructed staff to move forward with pursuing a 2016 ballot measure. George Dondero and Karena Pushnik will meet with this Committee at our September meeting to discuss the process. **(COMPLETED)**
 3. The Committee was asked to have members serve on the advisory group for the tax measure. **(IN PROGRESS)**

ONGOING ITEMS

1. Seacliff Village parking issues/Village redevelopment **(IN PROGRESS)**

1. Village businesses are being affected by parking issues stemming from the nearby state park. These issues affect current conditions, and future development plans within the Village. Committee will gather information and continue to monitor.

2. Central Coast Broadband Consortium (CCBC)

1. Committee will look at participating in monthly CCBC activities. **(IN PROGRESS)**
2. Committee will reach out to CCBC about conducting a "Broadband 101" seminar for the Santa Cruz County business community. **(IN PROGRESS)**

3. Affordable Housing Policy Recommendations (County of SC)

1. Committee will consult with GA/ED Committee about this issue. **(IN PROGRESS)**
2. County currently reviewing policy changes under Board of Supervisors direction.

4. Ocean Street Plan (City of Santa Cruz) **(IN PROGRESS)**

1. **Continued:** The Committee is continuing its review. Following the review process, the Committee will determine next steps.

5. Santa Cruz 115kV Reinforcement Project **(IN PROGRESS)**

1. **Continued:** PG&E has finalized a three (3) page informational handout. This handout has been distributed to the Committee. PG&E will provide updates.

6. Monterey Bay Community Power Project **(IN PROGRESS)**

1. **Continued:** Committee will check in with business groups in communities that have established similar programs to the one being studied in Santa Cruz County.
